In recognition of the respect that is due the court system when in session and the duty of the judge to require such respect, it is now, by virtue of my authority,

ORDERED AND DIRECTED:

That the following dress code shall be adhered to by all litigants and participants appearing or being in court.

DRESS CODE FOR COURTROOM:

- No tank tops
- No halter tops
- No muscle shirts
- No bare midriffs
- No shorts except for children under 12 years of age
- No hats or caps
- No T-shirts
- No sweat pants or sweat suits
- No clothing with foul language or obscene images
- No slippers, thongs or flip flops
- Boots or shoes must be worn at all times
- Pants must fit at the waist and not be more than one size too large or too small
- Pants must be worn at the belt line
- No visible body piercing except earrings
