Re: Calendar Year 2019 Holidays


Pursuant to K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 35–107, Section 8.9 of the Kansas Court Personnel Rules, and the executive memorandum issued by Governor Jeff Colyer on May 25, 2018, the following dates have been approved for calendar year 2019 holidays:

New Year's Day	Tuesday, January 1, 2019
Martin Luther King, Jr. Day	Monday, January 21, 2019
Presidents Day	Monday, February 18, 2019
Memorial Day	Monday, May 27, 2019
Independence Day	Thursday, July 4, 2019
Labor Day	Monday, September 2, 2019
Columbus Day	Monday, October 14, 2019
Veterans Day	Monday, November 11, 2019
Thanksgiving Day	Thursday, November 28, 2019
	Friday, November 29, 2019
Christmas Day	Wednesday, December 25, 2019

Observance of these holidays by a district court may be deferred whenever observance of the holiday would interfere with judicial proceedings in progress.

At the discretion of the chief judge and approval of the judicial administrator, a district court may remain open on any of the above designated holidays when the local county courthouse is open for business and observes as a substitute holiday a county designated holiday not otherwise observed by the Judicial Branch.
