<u>ORDER</u>

The court has considered and denies the application of the Kansas State Board of Education (KSBOE) to file an out-of-time *amicus curiae* brief. An *amicus* brief must be filed 30 days before oral argument. Kansas Supreme Court Rule 6.06(b)(1) (2019 Kan. S. Ct. R. 37). Oral argument in this case has been scheduled for May 9, 2019. *Gannon v. State*, 308 Kan. 372, 400, 420 P.3d 477 (2018). While the governor signed the bill into law on April 6, 2019, KSBOE's application was not filed until April 18, which itself is less than 30 days before oral argument.

Appellees' response is noted.
