Pursuant to K.S.A. 35-107, and amendments thereto, Section 8.9 of the Kansas Court Personnel Rules, and the executive memorandum issued by Governor Laura Kelly on August 24, 2021, the following dates have been approved for calendar year 2022 holidays.

New Year's Day Friday, December 31, 2021 Martin Luther King Jr. Day Monday, January 17, 2022 Presidents Day Monday, February 21, 2022 Memorial Day Monday, May 30, 2022 Independence Day Monday, July 4, 2022 Labor Day Monday, September 5, 2022 Columbus Day/Indigenous Peoples' Day Monday, October 10, 2022 Veterans Day Friday, November 11, 2022 Thanksgiving Day Thursday, November 24, 2022 Friday, November 25, 2022 Monday, December 26, 2022 Christmas Day

A district court may defer observance of a holiday if the holiday would interfere with judicial proceedings in progress.

At the discretion of the chief judge and approval of the judicial administrator, a district court may remain open on any of the above designated holidays when the local county courthouse is open for business and observes as a substitute holiday a county designated holiday not otherwise observed by the Judicial Branch.
