Availability of Electronic Filing System for Some Cases

Since October 12, 2023, the Kansas district and appellate courts have operated under Administrative Orders 2023-CC-073 and 2023-CC-074 regarding the unavailability of electronic filing systems.

Since November 9, 2023, the Kansas district and appellate courts have operated under Administrative Order 2023-RL-077 regarding service by email when electronic filing systems are unavailable.

This order rescinds and supersedes 2023-CC-073, 2023-CC-074, and 2023-RL-077 for all cases except for appeals to the Court of Appeals and Supreme Court.

Effective January 31, 2024, for all case types, other than appeals to the Court of Appeals and Supreme Court, a filing user must resume filing under the requirements of Supreme Court Rule 122 and Rule 122A for new case initiation and for filing in any other case that can be found in the Kansas Courts eFiling System.

Cases that predate this order and cannot be found in the Kansas Court eFiling System remain subject to 2023-CC-073, 2023-CC-074, and 2023-RL-077 until further order of this Court. Paper filings postmarked January 31, 2024, or prior, must be processed for filing by the clerk of the district court as they would have been under 2023-CC-073 and 2023-CC-074.

It is the intent of this order to require that a filer use efiling in any case, other than appeals to the Court of Appeals and Supreme Court, where the Kansas Court eFiling System is capable of accepting filings as of the date of the filing.
