Job Duties: This position involves highly responsible confidential legal work for the Hon. Sarah E. Warner of the Kansas Court of Appeals. A research attorney reviews the briefs and underlying case record, researches questions of law presented, prepares prehearing memoranda based on the facts of the case and applicable law, aids the judge in her decision-making, and performs other tasks as assigned by the judge.

Employment Dates: Employment from approximately August 9, 2021, through August 8, 2023.

Required Education and Experience: Preference will be given to applicants who are licensed to practice law in Kansas **OR** who have applied to sit for the Kansas 2021 bar exam and are eligible to obtain a temporary permit to practice law in Kansas **OR** who have a Uniform Bar Exam (UBE) result transferrable to Kansas per Supreme Court Rule 709A. **Before employment may begin**, applicants who have yet to take the Kansas bar must (1) apply to take the Kansas bar exam or apply to transfer their UBE score to Kansas, (2) submit proof they successfully completed the MPRE and the character and fitness investigation in Kansas, and (3) obtain a Kansas temporary permit to practice law. The applicant's law school GPA must rank in top one-third of the applicant's graduating class.

Required Abilities: Ability to recognize and analyze relevant facts, evidence, issues, and applicable law in complex cases. Ability to write clearly, thoroughly, and concisely in an organized manner. Familiarity with word processing and electronic legal research methods.
