Job Duties: This position provides specialized expertise assisting the courts and offices in the Kansas Judicial Branch with the implementation and maintenance of a centralized case management system. This position will work with external stakeholders (such as the district attorney's office, court trustee's office, sheriff's office, and community corrections). Complex analysis of system requirements and organizational structure will be required to recommend system design, controls, and protocols to ensure smooth integration of necessary information into and out of the system. Duties include managing the organization and documentation of business requirements to ensure the project team develop and implements solutions that meet customer needs and minimize defects prior to implementation; designing and developing application integration between systems; analyzing user requests to determine parameters of required programs; and assisting with the coordination and training of employees and external stakeholders.

- Required Education and Experience: Requires a bachelor's degree, preferably in computer science or business information systems with major course work in project management, or a related field, plus four years' experience performing duties similar to those described above. Additional relevant experience may be substituted for the required education on a year-for-year basis for the formal education requirements. Experience with three of more of the following development tools and technologies is required: MS Office, MS Project, MS Visio, MS SQL Server, DB2, Oracle, Sybase, Java, Access, SQL and Reporting Services.
- Desired Certification: Project Manager Professional certification, Kansas IT Project Management Methodology certification, or similar project management certification.
