Job Duties: Performs highly sensitive legal research and other professional legal services for the Kansas Supreme Court. Work may involve more complex cases and matters than are performed by the Supreme Court Research Attorney I position. Incumbent serves at the pleasure of the appointing justice.

Examples of Work Performed: Reviews, studies, researches, and annotates laws, court decisions, documents, opinions, briefs, and related legal authorities to process petitions for review to the Supreme Court, appeals, original actions, and other litigated matters. Performs supervisory duties over Supreme Court Research Attorneys I and interns as assigned by the appointing justice. Performs other duties as assigned.

Required Education and Experience: Graduation from an accredited law school. Two or more years of experience as a licensed attorney. Admission to the Kansas Bar or a temporary permit to practice law in Kansas. A minimum of two years' experience researching legal issues and writing research memoranda.
