

# Filer – Wave 2 Release Updates

1. If a submission included many eFiling system generated summons documents, the parties associated with the documents would not always retain the party's information within the summons document. This issue has now been fixed to where the party's information will be populated in the summons document even if there are many summons in the submission.
2. It was reported that if a filer attempted to do a Multi-case filing, there was not an appropriate way to remove a case that was inadvertently added to the list of case to file the document. With this release, the filer does now have the ability to remove a case number from the list of cases that that the document will be filed to. The filer needs to select the Remove button next to the case number prior to selecting the File on these Cases button.
