

Case Number Format for Cases Created in Odyssey

The District Courts of Kansas will be implementing a new statewide case management system over the next several months beginning August 5, 2019. The first counties to implement the Odyssey Case Management System are **Clay, Riley, Dickinson, Geary, Marion, and Morris counties**.

Any case that is initiated in the Odyssey Case Management Program will have a new case number format. The case number format will append the county abbreviation to the beginning of the case number. The case number also includes the four digit year, case type abbreviation, and the case number. The case number must be six digits. Therefore, to make the case number to be six digits, zeros may need to be appended to the case number to reach the six digits.

Example: A Criminal case filed in Riley county would have a case number of RL-2019-CR-000001.

- RL is the county abbreviation.
- 2019 is the year the case is filed
- CR is the case type abbreviation
- 000001 is the case number with the appended zeros to make the six digits.

Cases initiated in these counties prior to August 5, 2019, will have the case number format of Year, Case Type abbreviation, and case number of 6 digits.

Example: A Criminal case filed in Riley county prior to August 5, 2019, would have a case number format of 2019-CR-000001.
